We will be undertaking a tentative structuring of the 2011/2012 class lists as part of our placement meetings later in June. If parents wish to contribute information which is educational and curricular in nature for us to take into consideration when placing your child for next year, please deliver a letter to Mr. Hooper in the office by June 6th at 9:00 am. We will carefully consider all information that is shared. Staff spend a great deal of time on this process, discussing each child with the members of our Resource Team and the receiving teachers. Our goal is to compose balanced classes which are universally diverse whether they are a straight grade or combined grades. We cannot guarantee that we will be able to implement all requests, as the placement of students can be, for some grades, a very intricate process. While it may be tempting to request a particular teacher, please do not do so. These tentative placements will not be confirmed until students arrive back to school in September.
