Ages vary, however most youth attending are 10-14 year olds. Schedules subject to change 2 days before event. Drop in or email Adrian for more information.

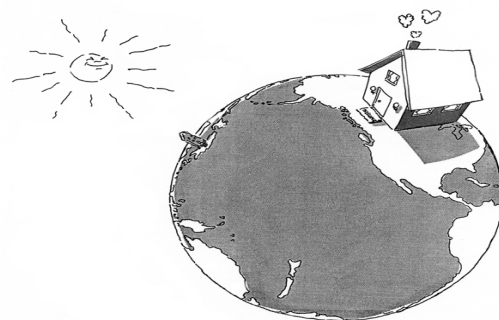
