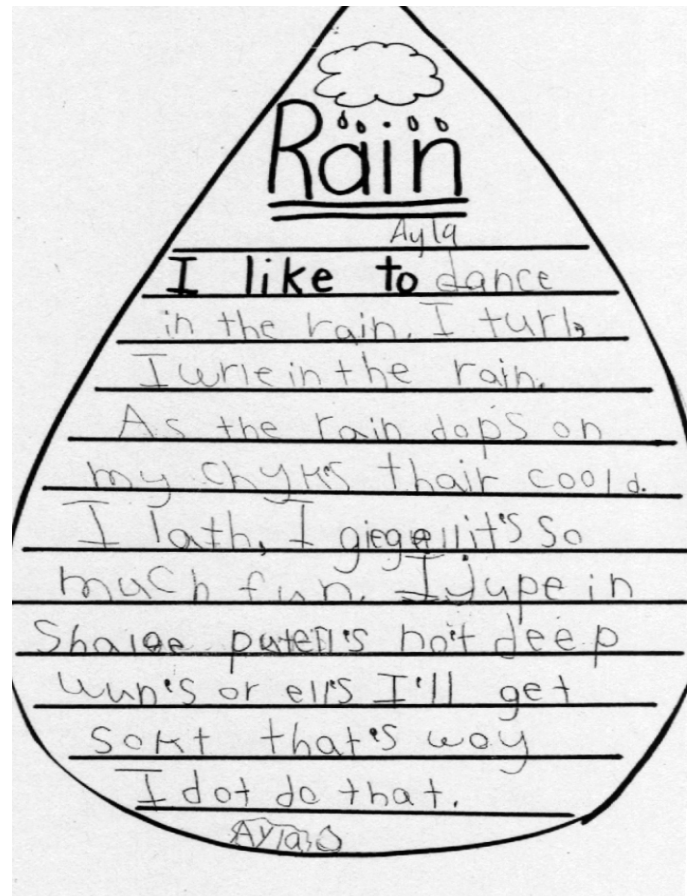
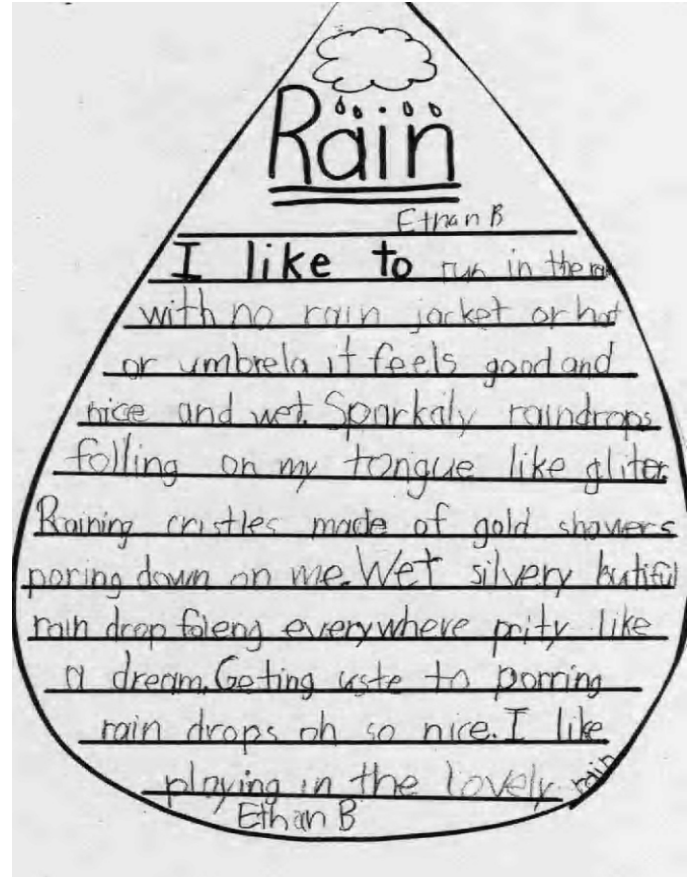


PREMIER CAMPBELL VISITS BAYVIEW
